

Sing! Choirs @ CBC: Terms and Conditions 2026

Membership of Sing! Choirs @ CBC means an acceptance of these terms and conditions with an understanding that it is not possible to make exceptions for individual circumstances.

CHOIR MEMBER MEMBERSHIP

From 1 January 2026 should you miss 4-5 consecutive sessions with no communication with the Musical Director you will be removed from the choir. You can return after communication with the Musical Director and confirmation that there is space or that you have been placed on the waiting list to return at a future date.

CHOIR MEMBER CONDUCT

Sing! Choirs aim to provide a positive experience for all involved and therefore, any negative behaviour towards the Choir Leader or fellow members, either in person, or written (including on social media), will result in membership being cancelled. You will also be immediately withdrawn from the members area on the website.

It is a privilege, not a right, to be in Sing! Choirs @ CBC so your space must be treated with respect, and consideration. Should you have any problems then you need to come to the Musical Director, ideally by email, with constructive ideas on how to solve any issues and not be a disruptive influence.

Anyone found misusing, and/or abusing the members area on the website will also have their membership cancelled.

Members are liable to pay for any breakages or damage to the contents, furniture, equipment etc. belonging to Sing! Choirs or the venue proprietor. Sing! Choirs accept no liability for loss or damage to property suffered on the premises or grounds.

The Musical Director has the right to ask any choir member to leave at any time and with no notice. This looks after the harmonious nature of the choir and the wellbeing of its members and the Musical Director

HEALTH AND SAFETY, EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

Sing! Choirs assumes no responsibility for accidents or injury to individuals participating in the sessions. The Choir Leader will make reasonable adjustments and offer support to members with health problems and disabilities.

Sing! Choirs' members are expected to adhere to any guidance put in place, such as social distancing and wearing of masks. Please refer to emails relating to the term we are in for specific requirements. Refusal to do this may result in you being removed from Sing! Choirs with immediate effect.

Sing! Choirs' members are responsible for their own property and well-being whilst attending all rehearsals and performances.

KEEPING WELL GUIDANCE

It will be your responsibility to consider any symptoms, and if there are any thoughts that you are not well you must not attend whether it be an event or rehearsal. This is important and we say that if you do not want to go through that thought process then do not sign up. We cannot prevent any illness, but we can do what we can to reduce the risk. This is everyone's responsibility.

Do not attend choir if you have had vomiting and/or diarrhoea, until 48 hours after the last episode.

We do ask that you don't attend if there is someone in your household who has Covid.

PAYMENTS AND REFUND POLICY

Payments for additional sessions / events / performances:

There are occasionally choral events which are not linked to Sing! Choirs at CBC to which as a Sing! Choirs' member you might be invited to join (along with others in the Sing! Choirs' family across Cambridgeshire): a fee is often required to join in with these events as these events are not part of Sing! Choirs at CBC whose choir practices and performances will remain free of charge to choir members for the foreseeable future.

Any emails issuing payment or availability deadline dates, linked to anything related to Sing! Choirs must be respected and adhered to by all Sing! Choirs' members, as per the Choir Member Conduct section.

If you attend an additional session and have not paid in advance (if required), payment will be expected on arrival, and at the absolute latest the next day by Bank Transfer.

Please don't pay money into the Sing! Choirs account (or make any form of payment), until asked and you have a confirmed space in the choir for any event.

The refund policy is always stated in the email linked to the payment but is once made there are no refunds or transfers.

Refusal to pay for events that have been signed up for, when a fee is required, will not be viewed lightly as the impact on the event can be significant and it is not deemed in the spirit of the way that these events are managed and set up to provide positive experiences for all.

PERFORMANCES / REHEARSALS

There is an expectation that if you sign up for Sing! Choirs @ CBC events that you will attend a good number of rehearsals prior to this event taking place. We may stipulate how many or discuss with individuals whether this is the right event to take part in at that point if attendance has been low. Either way the final decision must be respected. Attendance at rehearsals is important for you and for your fellow choir members so that everyone feels that they have a good team around them who are well prepared. Rehearsal at home (whilst important!) cannot replace rehearsal in the room all together.

It is your responsibility to fill in any Google Forms linked to the events – failure to do so will result in you being unable to perform. Forms are sent out with adequate notice, and with reminders in-person and by email to fill them in, along with receiving an email once you have filled it in as confirmation.

SESSION CANCELLATION

In the event that a session is cancelled due to severe weather, choir leader illness, or other circumstances beyond our control, members will be contacted by email.

SING! CHOIRS ARRANGEMENTS

The harmonies, concepts and resources used in Sing! Choirs are owned by Sing! Choirs. In taking part in any rehearsal, performance, workshop or event it is agreed that any use of resources, techniques and ideas will not be used, amended, copied or replicated at any other event, or to any group or in any venue. If found to be used, legal action will ensue against the individual.

PERSONAL INFORMATION, DATA PROTECTION, ADVERTISING

Your personal information will not be disclosed to any third party. Members should inform us of any important changes e.g. a change of email address. We reserve the right to take photographs, video and sound recordings during the sessions for use in our brochures, website and general advertising etc. We may from time to time contact you by email and provide additional facilities, such as audio downloads; those who do not have internet facilities may not be able to access some of these additional provisions.

Sing! Choirs reserves the right to change and amend these Terms and Conditions at any given time.
